## Category A: Visa exempt countries

Nationals of the following countries are exempt from visa:

- Gambia
- Guinea-Bissau
- Guinea
- Mali
- Mauritania

Nationals of the countries listed above are allowed to enter Senegal if they present the following documents:

- A valid passport, a national identity card or a laissez-passer; and
- International vaccination certificates required by health regulations.

Nationals of the following countries are also exempt from visa:

Nationals of the countries listed above are allowed to enter Senegal if they present the following documents:

- A valid passport; and
- A repatriation guarantee, a return ticket, a circular ticket or a travel document for a destination outside of Senegal; and
- International vaccination certificates required by health regulations.

Nationals of the countries listed below who have granted a visa waiver to Senegalese nationals or who have signed agreements to this effect with Senegal are exempt from visa:

- Algeria – diplomatic and service passports
- Austria – diplomatic passports
- Belgium – diplomatic passports
- Brazil – diplomatic and service passports
- Republic of the Congo
- Central African Republic
- France – diplomatic passports
- Iran – diplomatic passports for a stay of one month
- Kenya – diplomatic and service passports
- Libya – diplomatic and service passports
- Mauritius
- Morocco
- Netherlands – diplomatic passports
- Portugal – diplomatic passports
- Romania – diplomatic and service passports
- Spain – diplomatic passports
- Tunisia

Nationals of the countries listed above are allowed to enter Senegal if they present the following documents:

- A valid passport; and
- A guarantee of repatriation, a return ticket or a circular ticket or a travel document for a destination outside of Senegal; and
- International vaccination certificates required by health regulations.

Nationals of the countries listed above are allowed to enter Senegal if they present the following documents:

- A valid passport; and
- An entry visa, the issue of which, for a transit or a stay not exceeding three (3) months, is not subject to the prior compulsory authorisation of the Ministry of Interior; and

- A guarantee of repatriation, a return ticket or a circular ticket or a travel document for a destination outside of Senegal; and
- International vaccination certificates required by health regulations.

Nationals of the countries listed above are allowed to enter Senegal if they present the following documents:

- A valid passport; and
- An entry visa, the issue of which is subject to prior compulsory authorisation of the Ministry of Interior obtained at the nearest local embassy (*invitation letter to be provided by EITI International Secretariat once registration is confirmed*); and
- A guarantee of repatriation, a return ticket or a circular ticket or a travel document for a destination outside of Senegal; and
- International vaccination certificates required by health regulations.

## Important information

- Holders of official passports (diplomatic or service passports, United Nations, African Union or European Union laissez-passer) and persons in possession of ordinary passports who are on official mission in Senegal are exempt from visa fees for the duration of their mission if they are in possession of a valid passport/travel document, an official letter of invitation and/or a duly issued mission order.
- Refugees, stateless persons and nationals of countries not included in the above lists are subject to the compulsory prior consultation regime (Category C)
