ASM | Increased benefits for communities from formalized and legalized ASM operations across mineral supply chains

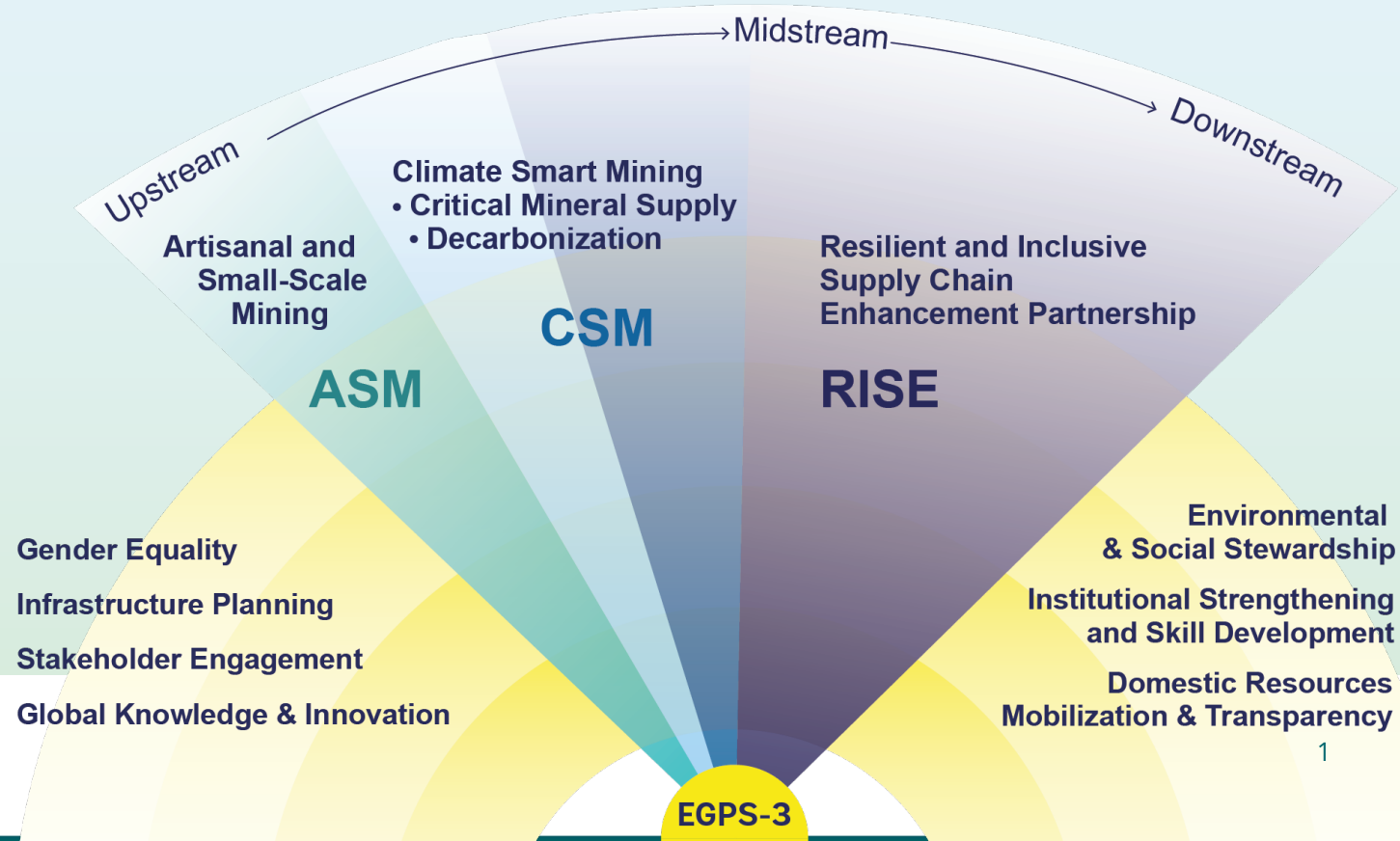
CSM | Shared benefits from an increased, sustainable, decarbonized, and responsibly managed production of critical minerals .
